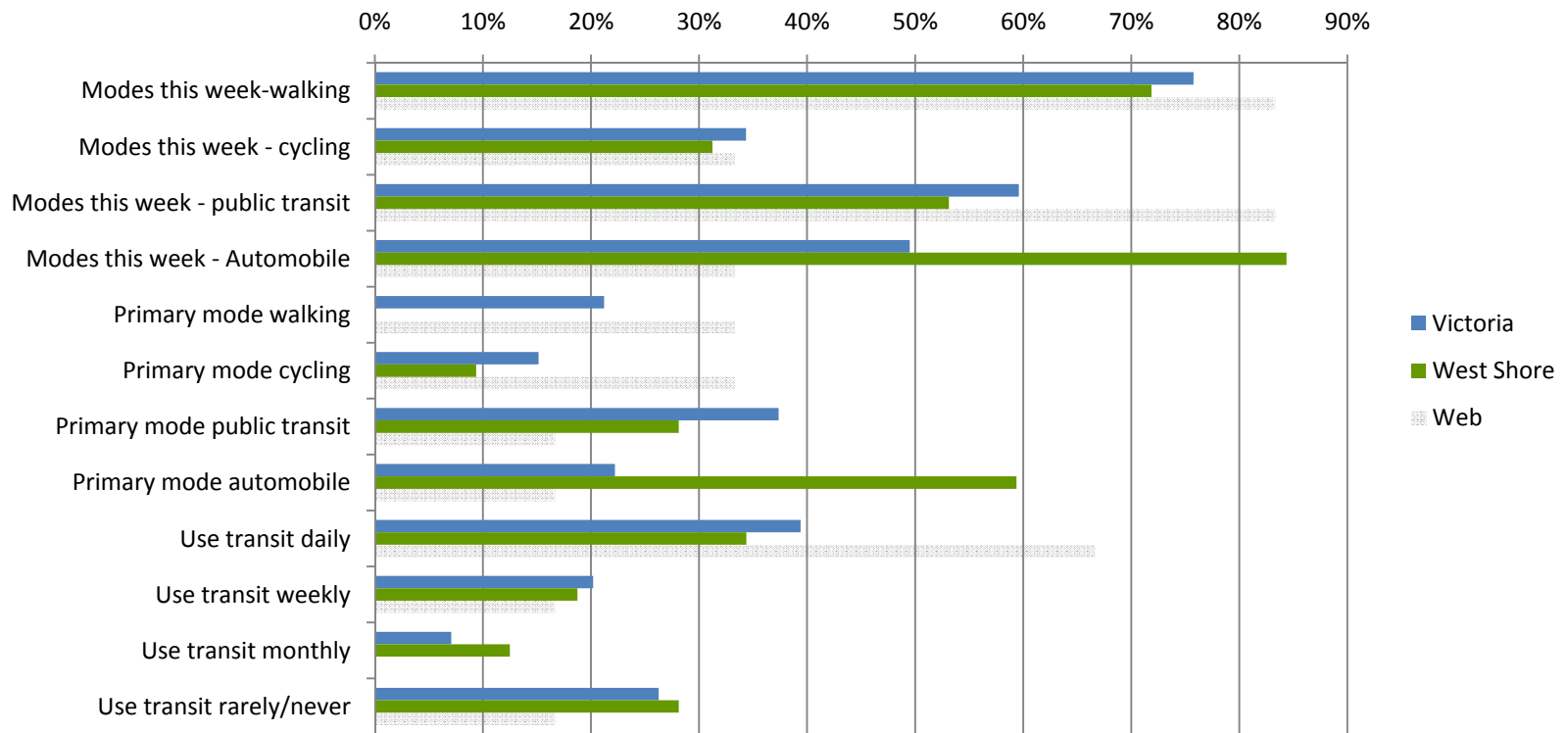

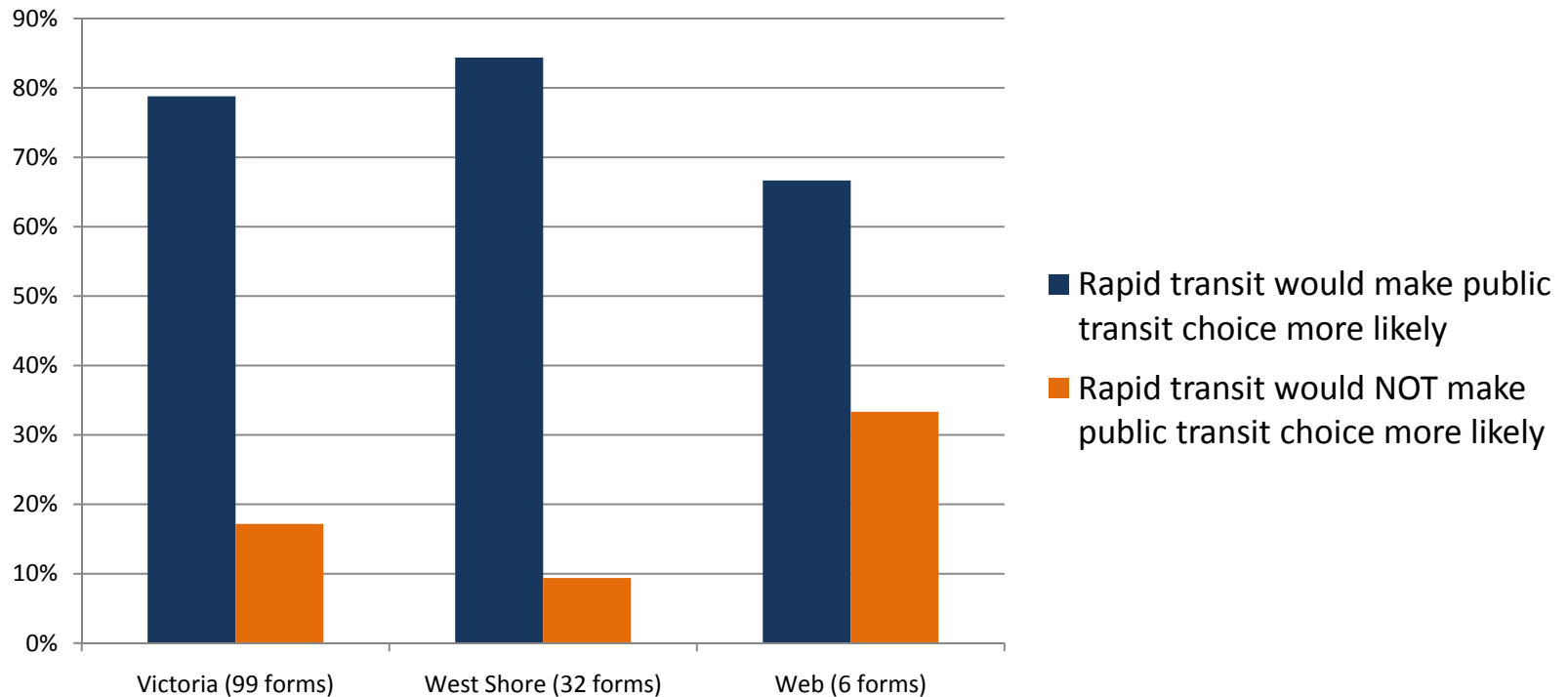

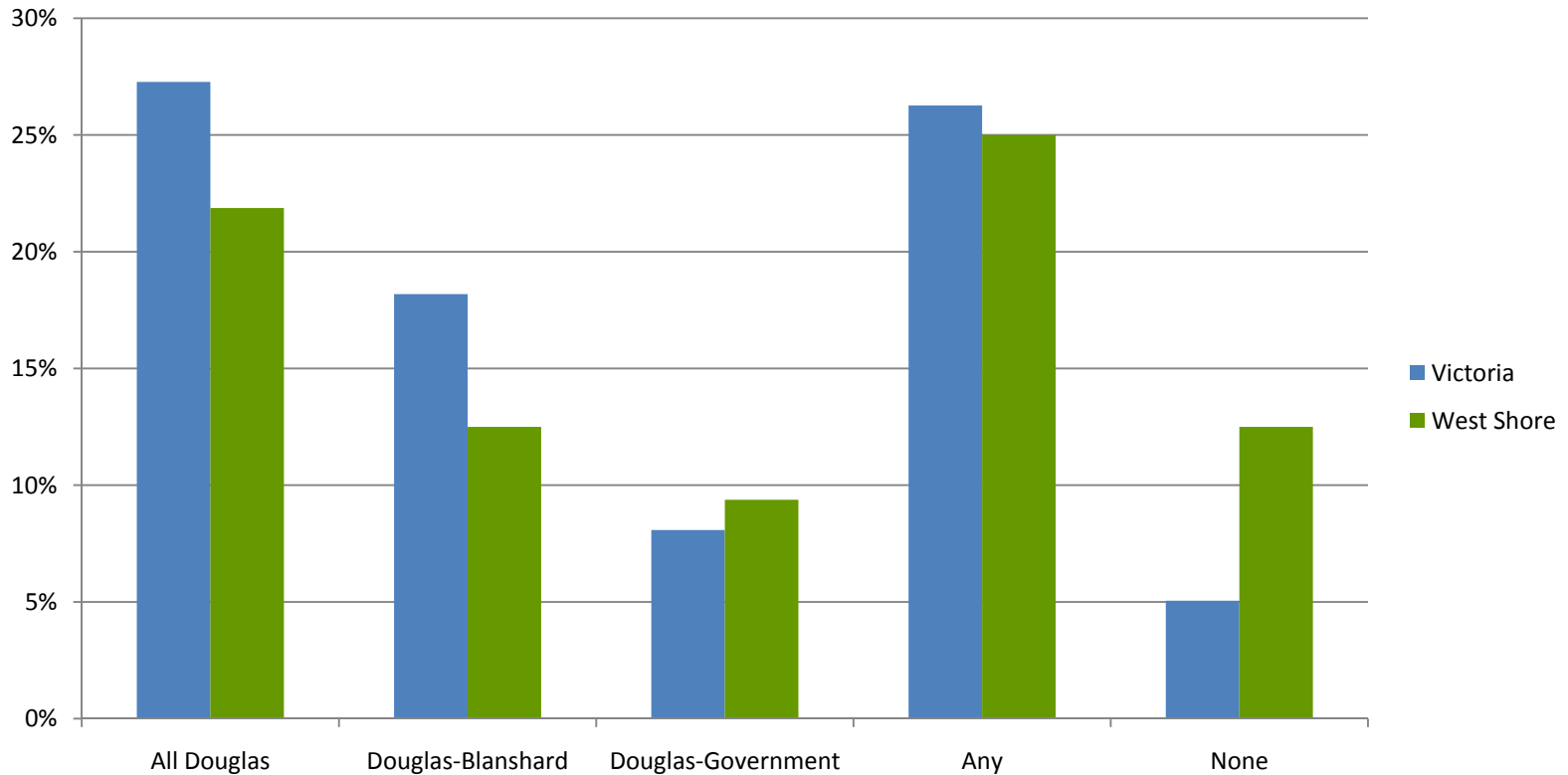

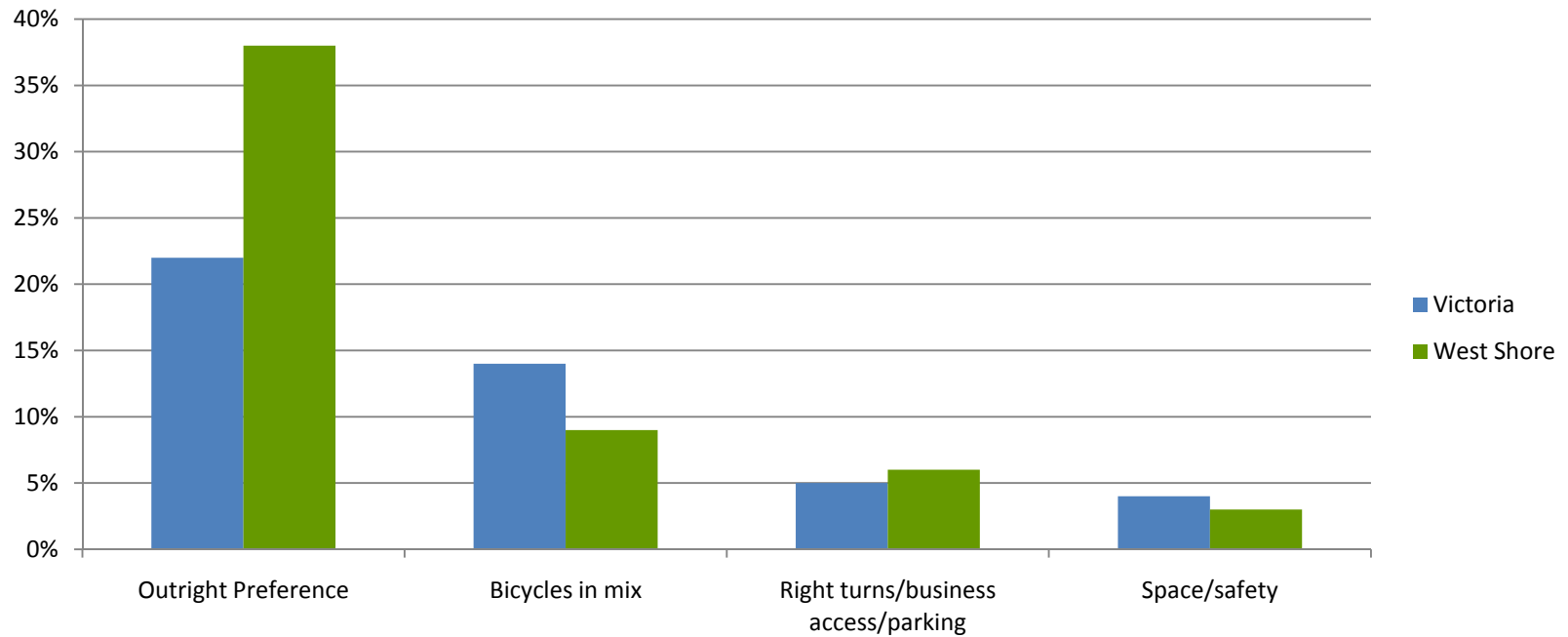

Uptown – Downtown Alignment Most Likely to be Used



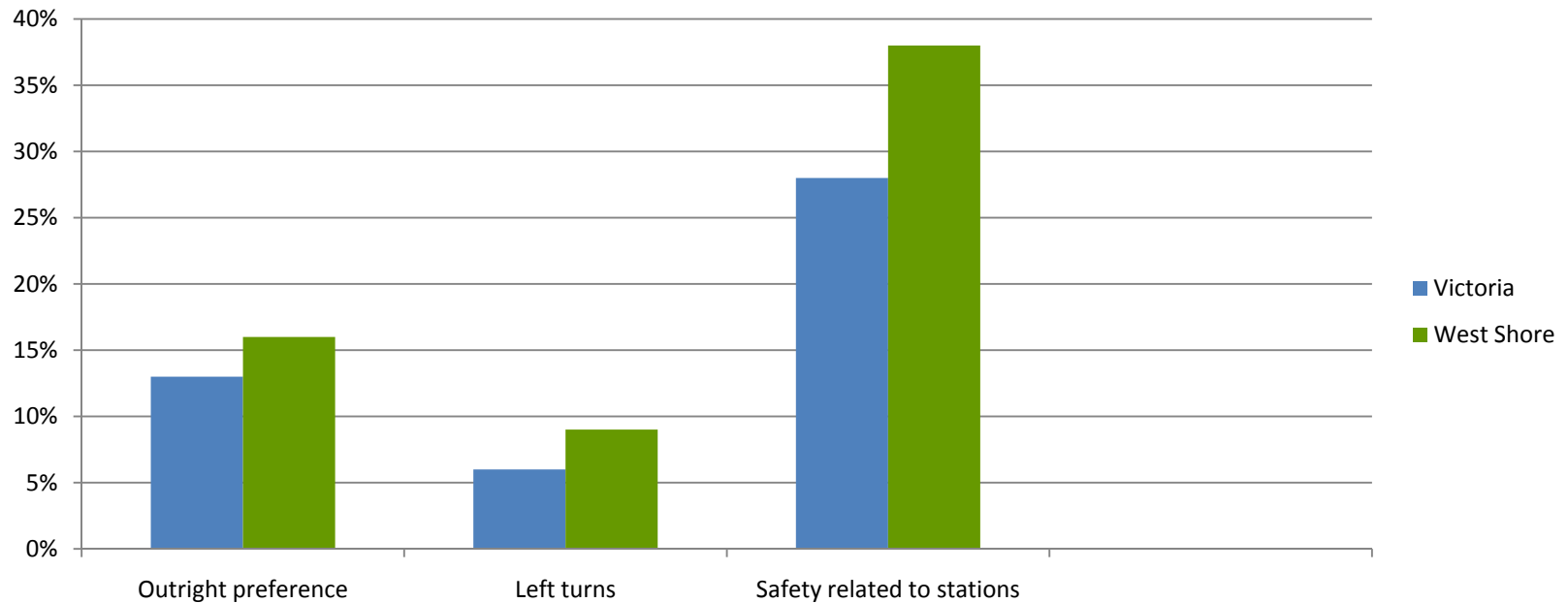

## Curbside Issues/Concerns

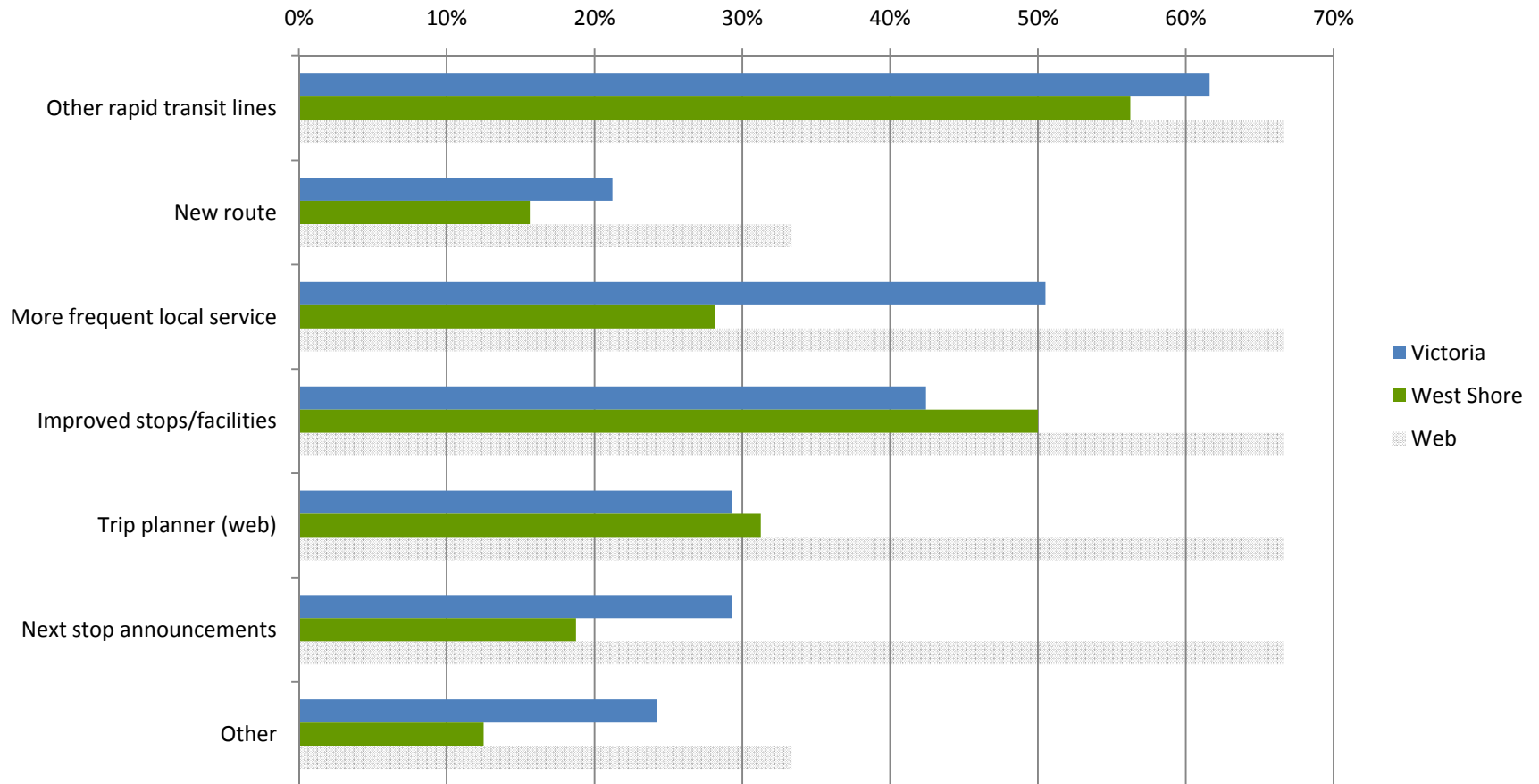

## Median Issues/Concerns

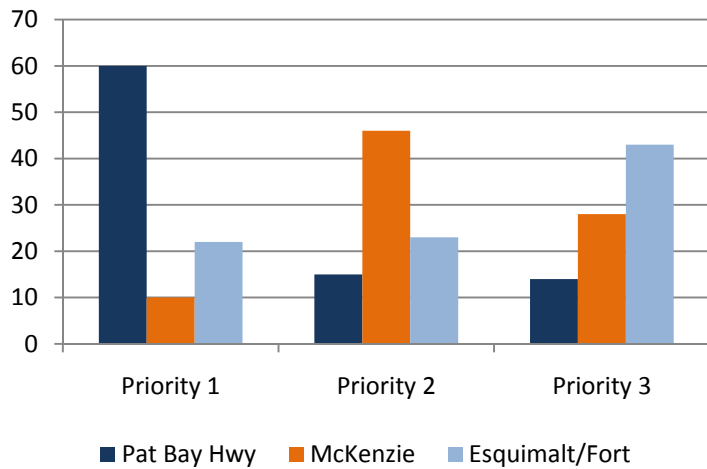

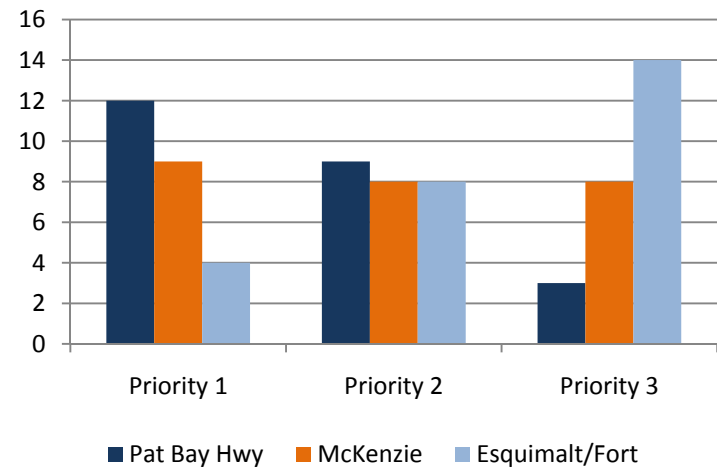

# Summary/Analysis

- Interest and feedback levels remain fairly constant
- Rapid transit strongly supported; will influence mode use
- All-Douglas alignment preferred Uptown-Downtown
- Curbside preferred over median arrangement
- Few concerns were expressed over loss of GP lane
