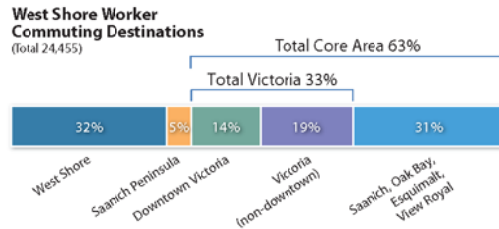


Key Findings to Date

Some Key Findings and Observations

- 32% of West Shore workers remain in West Shore
 - 63% work in CRD's urban core, including Victoria & Saanich
 - 33% work in Victoria
 - 14% (and declining) work in downtown Victoria



- West Shore has largest population growth in Capital Region from 50,000 (1996) to 96,000 (2026 projected)
- Travel in the region for non-work personal trips (shopping, medical, etc.) has increased; mid-day travel is up, indicating need for all-day service.
- Exclusive right of way is essential to developing the rapid transit network (for reliability, speed, etc.)
- West Shore needs to link to the region (including up-Island, UVic, Camosun, Saanich Peninsula and downtown)
